KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 76-45

AN ORDINANCE CALLING FOR AN ELECTION IN THE NORTH KENAI RECREATION SERVICE AREA FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF BROAD RECREATION POWERS.

WHEREAS, Title 16, Chapter 4, Kenai Peninsula Borough Code of Ordinances provides the manner in which service areas shall be established but does not prescribe the method by which powers of an existing district may be enlarged; and

WHEREAS, AS 29.63.90 provides that any exercise of powers must be approved by the voters; and

WHEREAS, the Board of the North Peninsula Recreation Service Area has requested a broadening of their recreation powers, to include all forms of recreation; and

WHEREAS, the assembly would propose the following amendment to the powers of the service area, subject to ratification by the voters; Now Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by adding a new paragraph to Title 16, Chapter 16, Section 80, which shall read as follows:

"The district and board are empowered with all recreation services and powers, including but not by way of limitation the planning design,

development, construction, maintenance, conducting and administering of any recreational activity project, service, program, whether for adults, or youth."

Section 2. That this ordinance should be placed on the ballot in the regular municipal election on October 5, 1976, for approval or rejection of the voters.

Section 3. This ordinance becomes effective after its enactment and approval by the voters of the North Kenai Recreation Service Area.
