KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 76-47

AN ORDINANCE PLACING ON THE BALLOT FOR THE NEXT GENERAL ELECTION THE QUESTION AS TO WHETHER THE CENTRAL KENAI PENINSULA HOSPITAL SERVICE AREA SHOULD PARTICIPATE IN THE PROVIDING OF A DETOXIFICATION CENTER.

WHEREAS, alcoholism and alcohol abuse constitutes a major health and social problem in the Kenai Peninsula Borough; and

WHEREAS, the establishment of a Detoxification Center would enhance the treatment and control of alcoholism; and

WHEREAS, the Cook Inlet Council on Alcoholism has been organized to assist in the treatment of alcoholism and has funds available for the operation of a Detoxification Center; and

WHEREAS, the Central Kenai Peninsula Hospital Service Area has been asked to financially assist the Cook Inlet Council on Alcoholism in establishing a Detoxification Center; and

WHEREAS, the Central Kenai Peninsula Hospital Service Area Board has, by resolution, requested the Kenai Borough Assembly to allow the citizens of the Service Area to vote on the question; Now Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1: There shall be placed on the ballot for the regular Borough election of October 5, 1976, with appropriate proposition

number to be designated by the Clerk, the following question:


"Shall the Central Kenai Peninsula Hospital Service Area powers be amended to include the authority to establish and to operate, or to participate in the expense of operating, a center for the treatment of alcoholism subject to such conditions as may be established by ordinance of the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly?"


