ORDINANCE 76-50

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND KPB 16.04.040 TO PROVIDE FOR PUBLIC HEARING OUTSIDE THE BOUNDARIES OF A PROPOSED SERVICE AREA WHEN FACILITIES IN THE AREA ARE NOT ADEQUATE TO HOLD THE PUBLIC MEETING.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1: That KPB 16.04.040 is hereby amended as follows:

"The Assembly or Mayor shall fix the time and place of a public hearing [WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE AREA PROPOSED TO BE ESTABLISHED AS A SERVICE AREA, WHICH PUBLIC HEARING MAY BE CONTINUED FROM TIME TO TIME AS THE ASSEMBLY MAY DECIDE. THE PUBLIC HEARING SHALL] to consider the necessity for the proposed service area. The place of the public hearing shall be within the boundaries of the area proposed to be established as a service area, or in a publicly owned building in closest proximity to any of the boundaries of the proposed service area, in the event that facilities within the boundaries are not adequate to hold the public meeting. Notice of the hearing shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the proposed service area not less than 1 week prior to the hearing, the notice of the hearing to be posted in each office which is utilized by the residents of the proposed service area. After hearing the interested persons favoring or opposing the proposed service area, the assembly may extend or shorten the boundaries of the proposed service area and may introduce an ordinance at the next regular meeting of the borough assembly to establish the proposed service area with whatever
