KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 76-70

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF BOROUGH FUNDS TO PROCEED THROUGH THE CONSTRUCTION DOCUMENTS PHASE OF ARCHITECTURAL SERVICES RELATING TO THE PROPOSED SOLDOTNA HIGH SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, it appears that the most favorable conditions for competitive bidding for public construction contracts will occur on or about March 1; and

WHEREAS, it appears that architectural services through the construction documents phase can be completed in time for such competitive bidding season if early authorization to proceed is obtained; and

WHEREAS, time is of the essence and may equate to substantial savings in construction costs; and

WHEREAS, the architectural services through the construction documents phase will not be discarded in future plans for a Soldotna High School.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That the Mayor be and he hereby is authorized to expend money from the unappropriated balances in the borough treasury in an amount not to exceed \$277,000 to complete the construction documents phase of the architectural services under contract for the proposed Soldotna High School.

Section 2. This ordinance takes effect on the date of enactment.
