ORDINANCE 77-1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2.08 OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH CODE OF ORDINANCES TO PROVIDE FOR THE AUTHORITY OF THE ASSEMBLY TO CHANGE THE DATE, TIME AND PLACE OF ITS REGULAR MEETINGS.

WHEREAS, elections and other events and extenuating circumstances sometimes require a change in the regular meeting date of the assembly.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That Section 2.08.020 is amended to read as follows:

2.08.020 Time and place--Procedure for changes--
Notice responsibility. Regular meetings of the assembly shall be held on the first and third Tuesday of each month at 7:30 p.m. in the assembly room of the Borough Administration Building [AT THE BOROUGH HEADQUARTERS.] unless for legitimate cause the assembly by resolution or motion provides for holding any particular regular meeting on another day, at another time, or place. The resolution or motion shall set forth the reason for changing the regular meeting. Public notice of the changed meeting shall be made in at least one newspaper of general circulation in the borough and the assembly clerk shall post a notice of the changed regular meeting at such public places and in the usual manner for giving public notice of assembly meetings. [THE HOUR AND PLACE OF THE MEETING MAY BE CHANGED FOR ANY 1 MEETING BY SIMPLE VOTE OF THE ASSEMBLY, PROVIDED SUCH ACTION IS TAKEN IN TIME TO PERMIT GIVING NOTICE OF THE MEETING IN AT LEAST 1 PAPER OF GENERAL CIRCULATION IN THE BOROUGH, POSTING THE NOTICE IN A PUBLIC PLACE IN EACH CITY AND TOWN IN THE BOROUGH, NOTIFYING ASSEMBLYMEN NOT PRESENT WHEN THE

ASSEMBLY CHANGES THE MEETING AND OTHERS DIRECTLY CONCERNED WITH ANY AGENDA ITEMS. THE ASSEMBLY CLERK IS RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL MEETING NOTICE.]

Section 2. This ordinance takes effect on the date of its enactment.
