## ORDINANCE 77-5

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF BOROUGH FUNDS TO PROCEED THROUGH THE CONSTRUCTION DOCUMENTS PHASES OF ARCHITECTURAL SERVICES RELATING TO PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS AT PUBLIC SCHOOLS AT TUSTUMENA, ANCHOR POINT, STERLING AND HOMER HIGH.

WHEREAS, it appears that the most favorable conditions for competitive bidding for public construction contracts will occur on or about March 1; and

WHEREAS, it appears that architectural services through the construction documents phases can be completed in time for such competitive bidding season if early authorization to proceed is obtained; and

WHEREAS, time is of the essence and may equate to substantial savings in construction costs; and

WHEREAS, the architectural services through the construction documents phases will not necessarily be discarded as plans for these public school improvements.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Mayor be and he hereby is authorized to expend money from the unappropriated balances in the borough treasury in an amount not to exceed \$120,172.00 to complete the construction documents phases
