ORDINANCE 77-8

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION OF \$210,000 FOR CONSTRUCTION ON THE BOROUGH ADMINISTRATION BUILDING.

WHEREAS, the assembly has to-date appropriated \$250,000 for the construction of improvements to the borough administration building; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 77-6 proposes the appropriation of an additional \$147,000 from the federal revenue sharing trust fund for this project; and

WHEREAS, the approved plans and design of these improvements includes the construction of the second floor, the renovation of the first floor and computer room space in the basement, including installation of an elevator in accordance with federal and state requirements to provide access to the handicapped; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the total construction, based upon competitive bidding procedures, establishes a low bid of \$536,000; and

WHEREAS, it would most likely be more costly to fragment the project and to delay the construction; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the sum of \$210,000 is appropriated from the unencumbered balances in the borough treasury for

the purpose of constructing improvements on the borough administration building.

Section 2. That this appropriation of \$210,000 and the outstanding and contemplated appropriations of \$397,000 shall be expended to accomplish the design and construction necessary to construct the second floor addition, the renovation of the first floor, construction of computer room in the basement, and the installation of an elevator to accommodate all persons, including the handicapped.

Section 3. The ordinance shall be effective on the date of its enactment.
