KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 77-20

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$42,500 TO THE PLANNING DEPARTMENT FOR A FEASIBILITY STUDY OF THE FUTURE COMMERCIAL USE OF THE PROPOSED PACIFIC ALASKA L.N.G. DOCK IN THE NORTH KENAI AREA.

WHEREAS, Pacific Alaska L.N.G. Company will construct a dock in the North Kenai area to offload modular units for construction of their L.N.G. plant; and

WHEREAS, said dock will be dismantled at the end of the construction project; and

WHEREAS, the Overall Economic Development Program Committee has identified a priority need for additional marine terminal facilities to support anticipated economic and population growth on the Central Peninsula; and

WHEREAS, Pacific Alaska will contribute \$7,500 to provide the local cash contribution for the feasibility study; and

WHEREAS, the only cost to the Kenai Peninsula Borough will be normal administrative services,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Mayor be and he is authorized to accept and expend a grant award from the Economic Development Administration in the amount of \$35,000 for the purpose of conducting a feasibility study of future commercial use of the Pacific Alaska L.N.G. dock facility.

Section 2. That the Mayor be and he is authorized to accept and expend \$7,500 from the Pacific Alaska L.N.G. Company. The \$7,500 will constitute the local cash contribution required by the Economic Development Administration.


Section 3. That the Mayor be and he is authorized to contribute the equivalent of \$4,181 in in-kind administrative services for the administration of the project.

Section 4. That this ordinance takes effect on the date of enactment.


