KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
EMERGENCY ORDINANCE 77-27

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$3,000 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED SURPLUS OF THE BOROUGH TO RESTORE, REHABILITATE, OR REBUILD THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT OF A KILN AT THE SITE OF THE HOMER HIGH SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, on or about March 10, 1977, the kiln on the site of the Homer High School, which is used in the pottery classes at the high school, was destroyed by an explosion of undetermined origin; and

WHEREAS, the restoration and replacement of the kiln is necessary to the continuing pottery class program; and

WHEREAS, this immediate need of a kiln in the ongoing pottery classes constitutes an emergency requiring immediate action;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That \$3,000 is appropriated from the unappropriated surplus in the borough treasury to restore, rehabilitate or rebuild the kiln on the site of the Homer High School.

Section 2. That the restoration of the kiln be accomplished at the earliest possible time in order to resume instruction in pottery classes in the current school year.

Section 3. That the assembly finds a kiln is essential to instruction in pottery classes and the restoration of the kiln at the Homer High School constitutes an emergency, requiring immediate action.

Section 4. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
