ORDINANCE 77-64

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING ANTIRECESSION FISCAL ASSISTANCE GRANT FUNDS MADE AVAILABLE BY THE U.S. CONGRESS TO THE GENERAL FUND AND SCHOOL MAINTENANCE FUND FOR SALARY AND BENEFIT ADJUSTMENTS.

WHEREAS, the borough has been granted funds derived from the Antirecession Fiscal Assistance grant made available by the U.S. Congress; and

WHEREAS, such grant will expire if not appropriated within the six months allowed time; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds may be made available to the General Fund and School Maintenance Fund to provide ongoing services through salary and fringe benefit adjustments;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That the following appropriation be made to the General Fund and to the School Maintenance Fund for salary and fringe benefit adjustments:

General Fund (01).....	\$67,000
School Maintenance Fund (02).....	<u>22,000</u>
	\$89,000


This appropriation shall be made from the Antirecession Fiscal Assistance grant in the amount of \$89,000.

This ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
