ORDINANCE 77-65

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING ANTIRECESSION FISCAL ASSISTANCE GRANT FUNDS TO THE MAYOR'S DEPARTMENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF HIRING A PERSONNEL OFFICER.

WHEREAS, the borough has been granted funds derived from the Antirecession Fiscal Assistance grant made available by the U.S. Congress; and

WHEREAS, such grant will expire if not appropriated within the six months allowed time; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds may be made available through the Mayor's department for the hiring of a personnel director; and

WHEREAS, it has been agreed with the Kenai Peninsula Borough Employee's Association that a personnel officer will be on the staff;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

 $\underline{\text{Section 1.}}$ That the position of personnel officer at salary range 20 be created within the Mayor's department, as an administrative assistant to the Mayor.

Section 2. That \$20,000 be appropriated from Antirecession Fiscal Assistance funds for the purpose of providing equipment and manning this position from 1 January, 1978, through 30 June, 1978.

This ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
