ORDINANCE 77-68

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND RATIFYING A NEGOTIATED COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE BOROUGH AND THE KENAI BOROUGH EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION FOR A TERM ENDING JUNE 30, 1979.

WHEREAS, the Assembly by Resolution 77-32 acknowledged the formation of the Kenai Borough Employees Association; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly by Resolution 77-41 and Resolution 77-59 recognized the Kenai Borough Employees Association as the collective bargaining agent for fiscal year 1977-78; and

WHEREAS, these resolutions authorized the Assembly's Employee Labor Relations Committee and the Mayor to enter into negotiations to establish a mutually satisfactory employee relations policy, and to make recommendations to the Assembly in the form of a collective bargaining agreement regarding salaries, wages, hours, and other conditions of employment with the Borough; and

WHEREAS, that Committee and the Mayor and the Kenai Borough Employees Association have engaged in full and complete discussions and negotiations and have arrived at a complete negotiated agreement to recommend to the Assembly;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the collective bargaining Agreement between the Borough and the Kenai Borough Employees Association which has been negotiated and formulated pursuant to the authority contained in Resolutions 77-32, 77-41, and 77-59 of this assembly, is hereby approved and ratified; and

Kenai Peninsula Borough Ordinance 77-68 Page 1 of 2 Pages the Mayor is authorized to execute the Agreement on behalf of the Borough by virtue of the authority of this ordinance.

Syction 2. The collective bargaining Agreement authorized, approved, and ratified by this ordinance is stached to this ordinance and made a part of it as if fully sot forth in this ordinance. The Agreement is titled an Agreement between the Kenai Peninsula Borough and Kenai Borough Employees Association, consisting of 38 articles and 45 pages, and containing an Appendix A and Attachment I.

Section 3. On and after the execution of the Agreement, Title 3-Personnel, of the Borough Code of ordinances will not be applicable to the employees covered under the terms of the Agreement.

Section 4. This ordinance takes effect only after, or upon ratification of the collective bargaining Agreement by the Kenai Borough Employees Association as an official and authorized action of the Association.
