KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 78-2

AN ORDINANCE TO PERMIT THE SALE OF INTOXICATING BEVERAGES  
IN THE AREA WITHIN THE BOROUGH OUTSIDE CITIES DURING ELECTIONS.

WHEREAS, the Cities of Kenai, Seward, Soldotna, and Homer have elected to exercise their prerogative to permit the sale of intoxicating beverages during elections within their respective cities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Seldovia has not elected to permit the sale of intoxicating beverages during elections within that city; and

WHEREAS, the remaining area of the borough outside cities is subject to the present borough ordinance which prohibits the sale of intoxicating beverages during elections held within the borough outside cities; and

WHEREAS, this lack of uniformity results in unequal treatment of businesses selling and dispensing intoxicating beverages; and

WHEREAS, this lack of uniformity and unequal treatment does not serve any useful public purpose;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE  
KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the codified ordinances of the borough are amended to provide a new section 4.04.020 to provide as follows:


4.04.020 Sale of intoxicating beverages permitted. The sale of intoxicating beverages is not unlawful during elections held in the area of the borough outside cities, and the

provisions of AS 04.15.020 (c) do not apply.

Section 2. That present section 4.04.020 of the codified ordinances of the borough is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance takes effect on the day of its enactment.
