ORDINANCE 78-29

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING ANTI-RECESSION FUNDS TO VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS WITH-
 IN THE BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, the Workmen's Compensation insurance rates were increased by \$27,000 during fiscal year 1977-78; and

WHEREAS, over \$12,000 was required to pay unprogrammed accumulated compensatory and vacation time; and

WHEREAS, the cost of printing and mailing the additional forms required by Comptroller Division exceeded budgetary estimates by \$15,000; and

WHEREAS, real property tax foreclosure lists were published twice during the current fiscal year to bring tax foreclosures into current status, at an additional cost of \$11,000; and

WHEREAS, unprogrammed expenditures including increased costs of the Mayor's office total approximately \$65,000;

WHEREAS, approximately \$24,240 of these expenditures were absorbed by the operational departments within assigned budget allocations;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That funds totaling \$40,760 be appropriated from Anti-Recession Funds to various departmental accounts to partially cover the increased costs of Workmen's Compensation insurance, the increased costs of the Mayor's office, and for printing and mailing costs in the following amounts:
