KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 78-43

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF PUBLIC MONIES TO PROMOTE THE PASSAGE OF SCHOOL BOND ISSUES.

WHEREAS, there has been a continuing controversy and opposition by some members of the public to the use of public monies, or service in kind by public employees, in promoting school bond issues; and

WHEREAS, there have been contentions by some members of the public that school district employees provide services in kind to promote the passage of school bond issues; and

WHEREAS, the school district has filed political campaign expenditure reports indicating the expenditure of dollars, or services in kind, to promote the passage of school bond issues; and

WHEREAS, these expenditures are necessarily charged to appropriations in the school district budget;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. The Borough Code of ordinances is amended by adding a new section in Title 4 - Elections, Section 4.04.060 to provide:

4.04.060 Prohibition on Use of Public Monies to Promote the Passage of Issues. The use of public monies, and services of public employees in kind, to promote the passage of school bond issues is prohibited.


Section 2. This ordinance takes effect on the day of its enactment.
