KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 78-48
(SUBSTITUTE)

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$160,000 FOR PORT AND HARBOR DEVELOPMENT STUDIES, AND AUTHORIZING THE RECEIPT OF A GRANT AND EXPENDITURE OF STATE OF ALASKA COASTAL ENERGY IMPACT FUNDS TO REIMBURSE THE GENERAL FUND.

WHEREAS, the Borough does not have adequate data and information to project the future port and harbor needs of the Borough; and

WHEREAS, proper planning will assist in the ability to select the best sites for ports and harbors which will be able to serve the future industrial, commercial fishing and boating requirements in the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Borough should undertake a comprehensive study of the port and harbor requirements as a part of its areawide planning authority; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska, Department of Community and Regional Affairs, through the Coastal Energy Impact Program, has offered up to \$160,000 to fund a study of present and projected port and harbor needs;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the sum of \$160,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund to be used for a study of present and projected port and harbor needs in the borough. The funds are assigned to the Planning Department Budget Account 01-41610; Contract Services Fund 01.3401 \$156,000.00; Fund 01.3001 Travel and Subsistence \$4,000.00.

Section 2. That the Mayor is authorized to accept a grant of up to \$160,000 of Coastal Energy Impact Program funds from the State of Alaska, Department of Community and Regional Affairs, to reimburse the General Fund.

Section 3. That the Mayor is authorized to solicit proposals for a coastal energy impact study which will (a) assess the present and projected port and harbor needs within the Borough and (b) will evaluate potential port and harbor sites, and (c) will recommend specific actions by the Borough which will facilitate orderly development of port and harbor facilities in the Borough. The Mayor, with the concurrence of the Assembly, shall accept the proposal which he deems the most responsive, cost effective, and productive, and he is authorized to enter into an agreement for these contract services in an amount not to exceed \$156,000.

Sh Section 4. The Mayor, ~~upon the recommendation of the Planning Commission, and with the concurrence of the Assembly,~~ *may* appoint a port and harbor advisory committee which shall have available \$4,000 from the grant for travel and subsistence expenses associated with the developmental studies.

Section 5. That this ordinance is effective immediately upon enactment.
