KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 78-65

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FEDERAL ANTIRECESSION FISCAL ASSISTANCE GRANT FUNDS TO THE SCHOOL MAINTENANCE FUND FOR SALARY AND BENEFIT ADJUSTMENTS.

WHEREAS, the Borough has been granted certain federal Antirecession Fiscal Assistance funds; and

WHEREAS, these funds must be returned to the Grantor if not appropriated within six months from the date of receipt; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds may be used to provide salary and benefit adjustments for Borough school maintenance personnel; and

WHEREAS, the Borough's agreement with the Kenai Peninsula Borough Employees Association requires that employees covered by the agreement receive a cost-of-living adjustment as of October 1; and

WHEREAS, the required cost-of-living salary increase of 9.8 percent exceeds the funds set aside for this purpose;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the following appropriation be made from unappropriated Antirecession Fiscal Assistance funds and transferred to the School Maintenance Fund for salary and benefit adjustments:

School Maintenance Fund (02). . . . . \$37,200

Section 2. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
