KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 78-67

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REZONING OF LOTS 1 THROUGH 6, BLOCK 1, BUSH LANES SUBDIVISION, CITY OF KENAI, FROM SUBURBAN RESIDENTIAL TO GENERAL COMMERCIAL.

WHEREAS, certain owners of lands described as Lots 1 through 6, Block 1, Bush Lanes Subdivision, City of Kenai, which are located one block northwest of Kenaitze Chevron Station, at the intersection of Lilac Street and the Kenai Spur Road, be rezoned from Suburban Residential District to General Commercial District; and

WHEREAS, the City of Kenai Advisory Planning and Zoning Commission has recommended that the above described lots be rezoned from Suburban Residential District to General Commercial District; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Planning and Zoning Commission has recommended that the above described lots be rezoned from Suburban Residential District to General Commercial District;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That Lots 1 through 6, Block 1, Bush Lanes Subdivision, City of Kenai, are hereby rezoned from Suburban Residential District to General Commercial District.

Section 2. That the official zoning map for the City of Kenai be amended in accordance with this Ordinance.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
