## ORDINANCE 79-2

REZONING LOTS 3, 4, 5, 11 AND 12, MARATHON ADDITION TO SEWARD TOWNSITE, CITY OF SEWARD, FROM PUBLIC (P) SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL (R1) TO MULTI-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL (R3).

WHEREAS, a request has been filed by the City of Seward, the owner of Lots 3, 4, 5, 11, and 12, Marathon Addition to Seward Townsite, City of Seward, according to the plat filed with the Seward Recording District on the 14th day of August, 1952, to rezone the lots from public (P) and single family residential (R1) to multi-family residential district (R3); and

WHEREAS, the lots are located on either side of Lowell Street approximately 260 feet west of First Avenue, City of Seward; and

WHEREAS, the City of Seward Advisory Planning Commission has recommended that the lots be rezoned from public and single family residential to multi-family residential use;

WHEREAS, the Borough Planning Commission has recommended that the above described lots be rezoned in accordance with the recommendations of the City of Seward Advisory Planning and Zoning Commission;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BORCUGH:

Section 1. That Lots 3, 4, 5, 11, and 12, Marathon Addition to Seward Townsite, City of Seward, Alaska, as
