ORDINANCE 79-10

ESTABLISHING ADVISORY PLANNING COMMISSIONS IN THE COMMUNITIES OF COOPER LANDING, HOPE AND MOOSE PASS.

WHEREAS, the Borough exercises all planning and zoning powers in the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has established Advisory Planning and Zoning Commissions within cities of the Borough to advise the Planning Commission on matters of local concern; and

WHEREAS, there is a need for local advisory planning and zoning in the Cooper Landing, Hope and Moose Pass communities; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly supports local participation in planning and zoning matters;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- Section 1. That an advisory planning commission is established for the community of the Borough known as Cooper Landing.
- Section 2. That an advisory planning commission is established for the community of the Borough known as Hope.
- Section 3. That an advisory planning commission is established for the community of the Borough known as Moose Pass.

That each Advisory Planning Commission shall advise the Borough Planning Commission on planning id zoning matters affecting each community. The Advisory Planning Commission shall exercise such other duties as are delegated by Borough ordinance.

Section 5. The Advisory Planning Commissions shall consist of not more than seven members who reside within the respective community, who shall be appointed by the Mayor, with the consent of the assembly, to serve for a three year term. Nominations may be submitted to the Mayor by the non-profit community organizations within the individual communities, and by any other resident who may wish to place a name in nomination.

Section 6. The Mayor, with the concurrence of the assembly, shall establish administrative guidelines and procedures for the conduct of the Advisory Planning Commissions.

Section 7. This ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
