KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 79-13

AMENDING SECTION 2.08.090 OF THE BOROUGH CODE OF ORDINANCES  
PERTAINING TO THE PROCEDURE FOR THE INTRODUCTION AND  
REINTRODUCTION OF ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS.

WHEREAS, The Borough Code of ordinances currently  
prohibits the reintroduction of Assembly agenda items for  
a period of sixty (60) days after that item has been  
considered and rejected by the Assembly or vetoed by the  
Mayor; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to clarify this Assembly  
procedure;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE  
KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That Section 2.08.090 of the Borough Code  
of ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.08.090 [AGENDA--TIME FOR INTRODUCTION OF ITEMS.]  
Assembly Agenda--Introduction of Ordinances and  
Resolutions. Ordinances, resolutions and other items  
of business, to be introduced and considered [ITEMS  
FOR CONSIDERATION] by the borough assembly at a  
regular meeting of the assembly, [WITH THE EXCEPTION  
OF THE INTRODUCTION OF REGULAR ORDINANCES,] shall be  
set forth in [PLACED ON] a meeting agenda prepared  
by the Borough Clerk and distributed on [PRIOR TO THE  
CLOSE OF BUSINESS ON] the Thursday [NEXT] preceding  
the regular meeting. [AT WHICH THE ITEM IS TO BE  
CONSIDERED. IF THE THURSDAY ON WHICH THE AGENDA IS  
TO BE CLOSED IS A HOLIDAY, THEN THE AGENDA SHALL CLOSE  
AT THE CLOSE OF BUSINESS ON THE DAY NEXT PRECEDING  
WHICH IS NOT A HOLIDAY. AN ITEM WHICH HAS BEEN  
CONSIDERED AND REJECTED BY THE ASSEMBLY AFTER PUBLIC  
HEARING MAY BE REINTRODUCED AFTER 60 DAYS FOLLOWING

REJECTION BY THE ASSEMBLY, OR A VETO BY THE MAYOR WHICH IS NOT OVERRULED.] An ordinance which has been introduced to the assembly and disapproved after consideration and public hearing or which has been vetoed by the Mayor may not be reintroduced in the assembly for a period of 60 days following disapproval or veto. A resolution which has been disapproved by the assembly or vetoed by the Mayor may not be reintroduced in the assembly for a period of 60 days following disapproval or veto. The 60 days limitation does not apply to a motion to introduce an ordinance.

Section 2. That this Ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
