ORDINANCE 79-30

PROVISIONS FOR THE ACCRUAL OF INTEREST ON SERVICE AREA CASH BALANCES TO THE GENERAL PUND IN LIEU OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICE CHARGES.

WHEREAS, the service areas have cash balances that may accrue interest; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough general fund provides for tax collection and provides for accounting, payroll, legal, and other administrative services; and

WHEREAS, these costs are offset by interest earnings to the service area funds;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That all interest earnings from service area fund operating cash balances will accrue to the general fund.

Section 2. The general fund will not charge service areas for administrative services other than special project costs.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
