ORDINANCE 79-33

AMENDING Section 2.08.120 OF THE BOROUGH CODE SETTING OUT THE ORDER OF BUSINESS OF THE ASSEMBLY, AND SECTION 2.08.130 OF THE BOROUGH CODE REGARDING PUBLIC PRESENTATIONS TO THE ASSEMBLY.

WHEREAS, it is advisable to review the practices and procedures of the assembly from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the hearings on ordinances, and the consideration of resolutions, and the introduction of ordinances are all in the nature of legislative deliberations and actions;

WHEREAS, the consideration of all legislative matters as one segment of the meeting will accommodate those persons who are in attendance at the meeting in regard to pending legislative items; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Clerk has recommended that the order of business at assembly meetings be established to consider pending legislative matters in sequence;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the present Section 2.08.120 of the Borough Code is repealed, and re-enacted to read:

- A. Call to order and roll call;
- B. Pledge of allegiance;
- C. Seating of new assembly members;
- D. Agenda approval;
- E. Approval of Minutes of Previous Meeting;
- F. Ordinance hearings, or other public hearings;

- G. Consideration of resolutions;
- H. Introduction of ordinances;
- I. Formal presentations with prior notice;
- J. Committee reports;
- K. Mayor's report;
- L. School construction report;
- M. Other business;
- N. Assembly and mayor's comments;
- O. Public comments;
- P. Informational materials and reports;
- Q. Notice of next meeting and adjournment.

Section 2. That Section 2.08.130 of the Borough Code is amended to read:

Section 2.08.130 Public presentations—Requirements. Any member of the public desiring to make a formal presentation before the borough assembly at a regular meeting shall give 6 days' notice to [INFORM] the borough clerk [OF THE] and state the subject [HE DESIRES TO PRESENT] of the presentation to the assembly. If the subject concerns legislation being considered by the assembly in the form of an ordinance or resolution, the public presentation shall be made when the assembly considers the specific legislative item; and other formal presentations shall be made as provided in the agenda, or as otherwise provided by the assembly. The assembly may limit the time allowed for individual public presentations.

Section 3. This ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
