REZONING CERTAIN PORTIONS OF THE CLIFF ADDITION TO THE CITY OF SEWARD FROM ONE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT (R-1) TO MULTI-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT (R-3).

WHEREAS, the Seward Advisory Planning Commission, at the public hearing, has recommended that Lots 2, 3, 4 and 5, Block 7, and Lots 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 15 of Lot 8, all lying within the Cliff Addition, City of Seward, be rezoned from one-family residential district (R-1) to multi-family residential district (R-3); and

WHEREAS, the Borough Planning Commission, after public hearing, has recommended that this rezoning be enacted by the assembly as recommended by the Seward Advisory Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the properties which are the subject of this ordinance lie on the east and west sides of First Avenue south of Mill Street, Cliff Addition, City of Seward;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That Lots 2, 3, 4 and 5, of Block 7, and Lots $\overline{2}$, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 15 of Block 8, Cliff Addition, City of Seward, are hereby rezoned from one-family residential district (R-1) to multi-family residential district (R-3).

Section 2. That the official zoning map for the City of Seward shall be amended in accordance with rezoning accomplished by this ordinance.
