KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 79-75

EXEMPTING PURCHASES OF GASOLINE AND HOME HEATING OIL FROM
BOROUGH SALES TAX.

WHEREAS, the recent escalation in the retail prices of gasoline and home heating oil has seriously burdened consumers and has imposed substantial hardships upon numerous Borough residents; and

WHEREAS, the imposition of a Borough sales tax upon the retail sales of gasoline and home heating oil results in additional costs to be borne by consumers; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly finds that some form of relief to consumers from the excessive prices of gasoline and home heating oil is warranted, but that such relief is not likely to be forthcoming from the private sector;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH.

Section 1. That Section 5.16.090 of the Borough Code of ordinances is hereby amended by adding a new subsection to be numbered 5.16.090 (N), which reads:

(N) Sales of home heating oil and sales of gasoline, excluding marine and aviation gasoline.

Section 2. That the Mayor is authorized to effectuate this ordinance, which takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
