KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 80-1

APPROPRIATING \$115,619.00 FROM THE FEDERAL REVENUE SHARING FUND TO THE BOROUGH ADMINISTRATION BUILDING RENOVATION PROJECT FOR THE PURPOSE OF PERFORMING CERTAIN WORK.

WHEREAS, the Borough solicited bids for the Borough Administration Building Ground Floor Renovation Project, and accepted by Resolution 79-170, the low bid of Cordova Construction Company to perform the base project, plus Alternative No. 1; and

WHEREAS, a contract was not awarded for Alternatives No. 2 and No. 3, due to insufficient funds in the construction account; and

WHEREAS, Cordova Construction Company has kept open its bid to construct Alternatives No. 2 and No. 3 for the sum of \$115,619.00; and

WHEREAS, the construction of storage facilities, a supply room, a walk-in fireproof vault for the Finance Department, and necessary modification to the heating and ventilating systems are needed improvements to the Borough Administration Building; and

WHEREAS, federal revenue sharing funds can be used for this purpose;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the sum of \$115,619.00 is appropriated from the Federal Shared Revenue Fund No. 06-41810-4600 to the Borough Administration Building Account No. 64-19380-9007, to fund Alternatives No. 2 and No. 3 of the bid of Cordova Construction Company.

Section 2. That the bid of Cordova Construction Company to perform all work required by Alternatives No. 2 and No. 3 of the Borough Administration Building Ground Floor Renovation (1979) Project, in the amount of \$115,619.00 is accepted, and the contract of Cordova Construction Company shall be amended to include the revised scope of work.

Section 3. That the Mayor is authorized to effectuate this ordinance, which takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
