KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 80-10

INCREASING THE APPROPRIATION FOR THE SOLID WASTE TRANSFER SITE BUDGET BY \$55,000.

WHEREAS, the Borough provides solid waste disposal services throughout the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Borough provides for the collection of refuse in certain outlying areas through the use of transfer receptacles which must be transported by truck to central waste disposal landfills; and

WHEREAS, the collection of wastes at the transfer site and transportation to solid waste landfills are provided by private contractors whose rates are governed by Alaska Public Utilities Commission tariffs; and

WHEREAS, the Alaska Public Utilities Commission has granted the contractor's increases in their tariff rate which were not anticipated when the transfer site budget was approved for this fiscal year and these increased rates will result in a short fall in the transfer site budget account; and

WHEREAS, increased misuse of the transfer sites has resulted in unanticipated maintenance and policing of the transfer areas to prevent misuse of the sites, resulting in increased expenses for this activity;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:



Section 1. That the sum of \$50,000 is appropriated from the General Fund Unappropriated Surplus to Public Works Transfer Account No. 01-41732-3400.

Section 2. That the sum of \$5,000 is appropriated from the General Fund Unappropriated Surplus to the Public Works Other Maintenance Account No. 01-41733-3400.

Section 3. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
