SUBJECT: Ordinance 80-14

DATE: May 16, 1980

Ordinance 80-14 was referred to the Borough Planning Commission by the Assembly for review and recommendation. The Planning Commission, in turn, requested that the Advisory Planning Commissions in the cities review and comment on the ordinance.

The Advisory Planning Commissions each acted on Ordinance 80-14 on the following dates:

Each Advisory Planning Commission unanimously opposed the ordinance. Comments were that this matter was a local one and that local conditions should determine what uses should take place in certain areas of the city.

The Borough Planning Commission, on May 12, 1980, also moved to reject the ordinance for the same reason raised by the city advisory planning commissions.
