KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 80-2

APPROPRIATING \$215,000 FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A RIVER TRAINING STRUCTURE TO PROTECT THE SEWARD LANDFILL FROM EROSION.

WHEREAS, the Borough operates a sanitary landfill in the Seward area pursuant to a permit issued by the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation; and

WHEREAS, the continued operation and environmental safety of this landfill is threatened by continued erosion of the site by the Resurrection River; and

WHEREAS, continued erosion would create a serious health hazard in the Seward area and would result in the imposition of sanctions against the Borough for the operation of an unsafe and unhealthy landfill; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to erect a 1200 foot long, rock-faced River Training Structure to provide permanent erosion protection to the Seward landfill; and

WHEREAS, this structure should be erected prior to the breakup of the Resurrection River in the late spring of 1980; and

WHEREAS, the engineer's estimate for the design, survey and construction of the necessary improvements is \$215,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Assembly has already selected, by Resolution 79-169, the land upon which this structure will be erected and the State of Alaska has indicated its willingness to expedite transfer of this land;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:



Section 1. That the sum of \$215,000 is appropriated from the unappropriated funds of the General Fund to the Seward Landfill Capital Project Account No. 63-28780-9007, to be used for the survey, design and construction of the protective structure.

Section 2. That the mayor is authorized to initiate survey of the site and design of the project at the earliest feasible time.

Section 3. That the Mayor is authorized to effectuate this ordinance which takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
