Background:

Applicant: Hope-Sunrise Advisory Planning Commission

Legal Description: A portion of Tract D, NU-HOPE ALASKA  
TOWNSITE, Village of Hope, Sec. 34, T10N, R2W, S.M.

The community of Hope has requested a site on Borough Property in the village of Hope to be used as a community church site.

Public notice was published in the Peninsula Clarion on April 16 and 23, 1980.

The Kenai Peninsula Borough Planning and Zoning Commission held a public hearing on April 28, 1980 on this request.

After a discussion of the Commissioners, the following motion was passed:

"Move to recommend to the Assembly that the land in question be set aside for the purpose requested as soon as an identifiable, viable entity is formed and the land then be transferred, sold or leased."
