KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 80-44

AMENDING SECTION 2.08.050 OF THE BOROUGH CODE, RELATING TO
NOTICE OF RECONSIDERATION OF ASSEMBLY ACTION.

WHEREAS, Section 2.08.050 of the Borough Code establishes
a procedure for voting by the Assembly upon matters before it;
and

WHEREAS, the Assembly has not established any procedure
governing the use of a Notice of Reconsideration of matters
already decided by Assembly vote; and

WHEREAS, indiscriminate use of the Notice of Reconsideration
delays the implementation of matters decided by majority vote of
the Assembly, unnecessarily diverts the Assembly's time and
attention, and is subject to abuse;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE
KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That Section 2.08.050 is amended to read:

2.08.050 Voting--Recording of decisions and actions.

A. The final vote on each ordinance or resolution shall
be by roll call and the "yes" and "no" votes shall be recorded
in the journal of Assembly proceedings.


B. Actions other than those specified in A above, and
requiring a vote, may be by voice vote and the votes need not
be recorded provided the vote is unanimous. For such votes
the results shall be recorded accordingly.

C. For matters which are not substantive in nature, as
established by the Assembly practice, the President of the
Assembly may announce agreement in the Assembly without a
vote. Illustrations for guidance are: Adjournment; change
of order of business in any one meeting; receiving a report
or statement from an Assemblyman or the Mayor when specific
decision by the Assembly is not involved. Any Assemblyman
or the Mayor may require a vote and that the votes be recorded
for any subject.

D. Notice of Reconsideration may be given only at the meeting at which the action to be reconsidered was taken and immediate reconsideration at the same meeting shall not be allowed.

Section 2. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
