KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 80-46

PROVIDING THAT ALL LABOR-MANAGEMENT RELATIONS CONTRACT NEGOTIATIONS SHALL BE FINALIZED PRIOR TO THE ADOPTION OF THE ANNUAL BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the Assembly and the Borough Employees Association have agreed to collective bargaining regarding wages, hours, and benefits and other terms and conditions of employment; and

WHEREAS, the agreement adopted by the Assembly and the Association provides for periodic renegotiation of certain wages and benefits; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly must adopt a budget each year based upon expenditures determined prior to adoption of the budget; and

WHEREAS, preparation of the budget requires that increased expenditures for wages and benefits arising from renegotiation of the contract be included in the proposed budget, so that the Assembly may make adequate provisions for any increased costs in the budget and in setting the mill rate;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That Section 3.04.120 is amended by adding a new subsection to be numbered 3.04.120 (b) which reads:

b.) Negotiations of salaries, wages and employee benefits which require approval of the Borough Assembly prior to implementation shall be finalized prior to the adoption of the annual Borough general government budget, and any additional expenditures arising from the negotiation of
