KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 80-69

TO AMEND SECTION 2.08.080 OF THE BOROUGH CODE OF ORDINANCES BY ADOPTING ROBERT'S RULES OF ORDER AS THE ASSEMBLY'S RULES OF PARLIAMENTARY PROCEDURE.

WHEREAS, the Borough Assembly has adopted Mason's Manual of Legislative Procedure as the Assembly's rules of parliamentary procedure for the Assembly's deliberations and actions; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly finds Robert's Rules of Order are more commonly used by deliberative bodies than Mason's Manual of Legislative Procedure; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly finds that members of the general public are more familiar with Robert's Rules of Order than with parliamentary rules designed for legislative bodies as set out in Mason's Manual of Legislative Practice; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly prefers the use of Robert's Rules of Order in its legislative deliberations;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That Section 2.08.080 of the Borough Code is amended to read:

2.08.080 [MASON'S MANUAL OF LEGISLATIVE PROCEDURE] Robert's Rules of Order -- Adopted -- Scope -- Exception. The Borough assembly adopts as its rules of procedure [MASON'S MANUAL OF LEGISLATIVE PROCEDURE] Robert's Rules of Order in all respects except as specifically altered by this Code.

B. A motion made by an assemblymember does not require a second before consideration by the assembly.

Section 2. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
