KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 80-8

APPROPRIATING FUNDS FROM THE LAND TRUST FUND UNAPPROPRIATED BALANCE TO LAND TRUST FUND OPERATING EXPENSE.

WHEREAS, the Land Management Division was budgeted only for normal operating expenses for fiscal year 1979-80; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 79-53, providing for the disposal of certain parcels of Borough selected lands by lottery sale, was enacted on the 18th day of September, 1979, which was subsequent to the establishment of the 1979-80 operating budget; and

WHEREAS, said land lottery sale has cost the Borough \$18,000 over the Land Management budget to date; and

WHEREAS, certain preliminary costs were contracted for in the purchase of the school site within the city of Homer for a total amount of \$9,972.50;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That \$28,000 be appropriated from Land Trust Fund (fund 15) unappropriated balance to the following accounts in the Land Management Division of the Planning Department (code 41615):

0300	Part-time	\$ 2,000
0600	Social Security	200
0800	Workmen's Compensation	100
2200	Communications	700
2300	Advertising and Publications	6,000
2301	Printing	1,000
3400	Contract Services	8,000
8600	Land Acquisition	10,000

Section 2. That the Mayor is authorized to effectuate this ordinance which takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
