ORDINANCE 81-8 (AMENDED)

AMENDING THE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PUBLICATION OF LEGAL ADVERTISING BY THE BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, State statutes require that certain legal notices be published at a specific time or in a specific manner; and

WHEREAS, the publication of such notices regarding proposed Borough actions or legal actions may be the only source of such information available to citizens residing both inside and outside the Borough and the Assembly finds that the widest possible dissemination should be encouraged; and

WHEREAS, the cost of such advertising is a significant item in the Borough budget and that competition for the publication of legal notices will result in cost savings to the Borough;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That section 5.08.060 (B) of the Borough Code is amended to read:

"B. Every legal notice or other advertisement pertaining only to the central peninsula area will be placed in a weekly or daily newspaper of general circulation located in that area (AND HOLDING A U.S. POSTAL SERVICE PERMIT FOR SECOND CLASS MAILING).

Legal advertising that pertains only to the Homer area will be published in (EACH) a newspaper of general circulation located in the Homer area (AND HOLDING A U. S. POSTAL SERVICE PERMIT FOR SECOND CLASS MAILING); and legal advertisements pertaining to the Seward area will be published

Kenai Peninsula Borough Ordinance 81-8 (Amended) Page 1 of 2 Pages in (EACH) a newspaper of general circulation located in the Seward area. (AND HOLDING A U.S. POSTAL SERVICE PERMIT FOR SECOND CLASS MAILING). Legal advertising that pertains especially to Homer and Seward areas shall be included in local newspapers of general circulation in the Borough, either for broader coverage to interested persons, or in the event that Homer and Seward do not have a local newspaper.

Section 2. That subsection 5.08.060 (C) of the Borough Code is amended to read:

"C. Legal advertising of Borough-wide significance will be published (ONLY) in a newspaper of general circulation within the Borough (WHICH HOLD A U.S. POSTAL SERVICE PERMIT FOR SECOND CLASS MAILING OR WHOSE APPLICATION FOR A SECOND CLASS PERMIT HAS BEEN ACCEPTED BY THE U.S. POSTAL SERVICE AND IS UNDER CONSIDERATION FOR A PERIOD NOT TO EXCEED 120 DAYS).

Section 3. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
