ORDINANCE 81-9

ACKNOWLEDGING RECEIPT OF AUTHORIZATION TO EXPEND CERTAIN FUNDS FOR LOCAL SERVICE ROADS AND TRAILS AND MAKING APPROPRIATIONS.

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska has notified the Borough that the sum of \$447,714.00 has been allocated to the Borough from the proceeds of the 1980 local service roads and trails bond issue; and

WHEREAS, the State has authorized the Borough to expend funds in the amount of the allocation on local service roads and trails and will reimburse the Borough for one hundred percent (100%) of expenditures pursuant to the authorization; and

WHEREAS, The Assembly by Resolution 81-5 (Substitute) requires that certain proceeds of the bond issue be allocated to each eligible city in accordance with an allocation formula similar to that employed by the State in making its allocation to the Borough.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1: That the Assembly acknowledges the allocation of \$447,714.00 in proceeds from the 1980 local service roads and trails bond issue to the Kenai Peninsula Borough and further acknowledges authorization from the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities to expend funds in the amount of the allocation subject to full reimbursement from bond proceeds.

Section 2: That estimated revenue in the local service roads and trails revenue account #07-34160 is increased by \$447,714.00.

Section 3. That the sum of \$388,077.00 is appropriated to the local service roads and trails Borough unassigned contingency account #07-21027-9007 for the construction of roads and trails in the areas outside cities.

Section 4: That the sum of \$27,535.00 is appropriated to the Soldotna local service roads and trails unassigned contingency account #07-22005-9007.

Section 5. That the sum of \$6,130.00 is appropriated to the Seldovia unassigned contingency account #07-23002-9007.

Section 6. That the sum of \$25,972.00 is appropriated to the Homer local service roads and trails unassigned contingency account #07-24002-9007.

Section 7. That the Mayor is authorized to affectuate this ordinance, which takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
