KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 81-108

AMENDING SECTION 2.08.020 OF THE BOROUGH CODE OF ORDINANCES TO PROVIDE THAT REGULAR MEETINGS OF THE ASSEMBLY SHALL BE HELD ONCE A MONTH.

WHEREAS, the State Municipal Code provides that the Assembly shall meet at least once every month; and

WHEREAS, KPB 2.08.020 now provides that regular meetings of the Assembly shall be held twice a month on the first and third Tuesday of each month; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly finds that it is feasible to conduct the Assembly's business at a regular monthly meeting; and

WHEREAS, a single monthly meeting will enable the Assembly to expedite its business and decrease the cost of the Assembly's operations; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly members will be able to devote more time to legislative matters under consideration if the time between meetings is extended;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That KPB 2.08.020 is amended to read:

2.08.020 Time and place--Procedure for changes--
Notice responsibility. Regular meetings of the A(a)ssembly shall be held on the first (AND THIRD) Tuesday of each month at 7:30 p.m. in the assembly room of the Borough Administration Building unless for legitimate cause the A(a)ssembly by resolution or motion provides for holding any particular regular meeting on another day, at another time, or place. The resolution or motion shall set forth the reason for changing the regular meeting. Public notice of the changed meeting shall be made in at least one newspaper of general circulation in the B(b)orough and the A(a)ssembly C(c)lerk shall post a notice of the changed regular meeting at such public places and in the usual manner for giving public notice of A(a)ssembly meetings. All regular legislative

business of the A(a)ssembly shall be concluded not later than 12:00 o'clock midnight, and any pending agenda items shall be taken up at the next meeting. However, the A(a)ssembly shall not adjourn until all presentations and comments by members of the general public have been heard. This time for conclusion of legislative business is mandatory.

Section 2. That this takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
