KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 81-110

PROVIDING THAT FORMAL PRESENTATIONS TO THE ASSEMBLY UPON MATTERS NOT CONTAINED IN THE ASSEMBLY'S AGENDA FOR THAT MEETING SHALL BE LIMITED TO 10 MINUTES DURATION PER TOPIC.

WHEREAS, many persons have come before the Assembly to make presentations upon matters not contained in the Assembly's agenda for that meeting and these presentations occur prior to consideration of the meeting's legislative business; and

WHEREAS, presentation upon these topics frequently involve the testimony of several persons and the use of graphics or slide presentations; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly has been unable to consistently meet its midnight deadline due, in part, to the length of presentations at the beginning of this meeting, rather than to a lengthy agenda; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly finds it has been unable to begin its legislative agenda until 9:00 p.m. or later during its last two meetings due to lengthy presentations upon topics not contained on the Assembly's agenda for that meeting; and

WHEREAS, people who are scheduled to speak on regular legislative business have in the past been forced to delay their presentations to the Assembly until late in the meeting in order to accommodate public presentations not dealing with any legislative item on the agenda;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That Section 2.08.130 of the Borough Code is amended to read:

2.08.130 Public presentations--Requirements.

A. Any member of the public desiring to make a formal presentation before the B(b)orough A(a)ssembly at a regular meeting shall give 6 days' notice to the B(b)orough C(c)lerk and state the subject of the presentation to the A(a)ssembly. If the subject concerns legislation being considered by the A(a)ssembly in the form of an ordinance or resolution, a public pre-

sentation may be made without prior notice when the A(a)ssembly considers the specific legislative items, or as otherwise provided by the assembly. Any other formal presentations shall be made as approved in the agenda. The time allowed for individual public presentations is 3 minutes, which shall be strictly enforced by the president.

B. The total time permitted for formal presentations with prior notice concerning a subject not contained in the Assembly's agenda for that meeting shall be limited to 10 minutes per topic, regardless of the number of persons participating in the presentation. The Assembly President may, with the concurrence of a majority of the Assembly, allow for additional time. This time limit shall not apply to formal presentations made at the request of the Mayor or the Assembly. This section does not preclude the Borough Clerk from scheduling presentations which will exceed 10 minutes prior to the beginning of an assembly meeting or before the assembly as a committee of the whole.

Section 2. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
