ORDINANCE 81-111

AMENDING SECTION 2.08.120 OF THE BOROUGH CODE OF ORDINANCES
RELATING TO THE ASSEMBLY'S ORDER OF BUSINESS.

WHEREAS, the Assembly has prescribed a midnight deadline for acting on legislative matters to be taken up from the agenda of an Assembly meeting; and

WHEREAS, the present order of business permits public presentations upon matters not contained in the Assembly's agenda for the meeting to be made prior to the legislative business of the Assembly; and

WHEREAS, this prime time should be devoted to legislative matters as the primary function of the Assembly at its meetings; and

WHEREAS, public presentations should be treated as an accommodation of the public following Assembly action on legislative matters; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly's well-intentioned accommodation of the public has made the legislative deliberations of secondary importance; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to re-establish an order of business for the Assembly which will be a more efficient use of time which will still permit ample opportunity for public comments and presentations;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That KPB 2.08.120 is amended to read:

2.08.120 Order of business. The order of business shall be:

- A. Call to order;
- B. Pledge of allegiance;
- C. (C. ROLL CALL;) Invocation;
- D. (D. INVOCATION;) Roll call;
- E. Seating of new assembly members;
- F. Approval of minutes of previous meetings;

- G. (Agenda approval;) Committee reports;
- H. (PUBLIC PRESENTATIONS UPON MATTERS NOT CONTAINED IN THE ASSEMBLY'S AGENDA FOR THE MEETING;) Agenda approval;
- (I. COMMITTEE REPORTS;)
- I. (J.) Ordinance hearings or other public hearings;
- J. (M.) Introduction or ordinances;
- K. Consideration of resolutions;
- L. Pending legislation;
- M. (N.) Formal presentations with prior notice upon matters not on the meeting agenda;
- N. (O.) Mayor's report;
- O. (P.) Other business;
- P. (Q.) Assembly and M(m)ayor's comments;
- Q. (R.) PUBLIC COMMENTS; Public comments and public presentations upon matters not contained in the Assembly's agenda for the meeting;
- R. (S.) Informational materials and reports;
- S. (T.) Notice of next meeting and adjournment.

Section 2. That this ordinance takes effect on December 1, 1981.
