KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 81-112

PROVIDING FOR THE ACQUISITION OF MUNICIPAL POWERS NECESSARY TO PROVIDE SEWERS AND SEWAGE AND SEPTAGE WASTE TREATMENT FACILITIES IN THE BOROUGH OUTSIDE CITIES.

WHEREAS, the Borough currently exercises solid waste collection and disposal powers within the entire area of the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the disposal of septic tank sediments, known as septage waste, has become an increasingly serious problem requiring immediate attention by the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly desires that the Borough provide for the treatment and disposal of septage wastes generated in the areas outside cities as soon as possible and in the most efficient manner; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly finds that the lack of facilities for the disposal of septage wastes is now a serious threat to the public health; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly finds that the septage waste problem in the Borough area outside cities requires immediate corrective action; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly finds that the Borough should consider the acquisition of municipal powers necessary to deal with the problem;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENIA PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Assembly proposes the acquisition of the additional municipal power to provide sewers and sewage and septage waste treatment facilities in the area outside cities. The Borough shall seek to have the identical power transferred from cities within the Borough, or propose joint Borough-city exercise of the power, before exercising this power outside cities only.

Section 2. The Assembly shall hold at least one public hearing in the Borough on the question. The Assembly shall

then evaluate the ability of the Borough to exercise the powers and make its findings public.

Section 3. The Assembly shall, within 30 days after its findings have been made public, order an election on the question in the Borough area outside cities. The election shall be held at least 30 days after the order for an election, and not later than the next regular election.

Section 4. This ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
