KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 81-123

AMENDING SECTION 2.04.060 OF THE BOROUGH CODE OF ORDINANCES REGARDING THE SALARY OF THE MAYOR.

WHEREAS, Section 2.04.060(A) of the Borough Code of ordinances states that the salary of the Mayor shall be adjusted by the cost of living indexes from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the salary is subject to readjustment in accordance with the National Consumer Price Index at the end of every term of office; and

WHEREAS, Section 29.23.530 of the Alaska Statutes provides that the salary of the Mayor can be increased by the Assembly from time to time during a mayor's term of office; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Code of ordinances should set forth the salary figures to eliminate the uncertainty of referring to the National Consumer Price Index which requires calculation of an amount not set forth in the Borough Code of ordinances;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That Section 2.04.060 of the Borough Code of ordinances is repealed.

Section 2. That Chapter 2.04 of the Borough Code of ordinances is amended by enacting Section 2.04.060 to read:

"2.04.060 Salary. A. The salary for the Borough Mayor is established at \$61,568 per year.

B. The Assembly may provide for an increase in the Mayor's salary to take effect at the beginning of a term of office, but the Assembly may not reduce the salary of the Borough Mayor during his term of office."

Section 3. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
