KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH  
ORDINANCE 81-128

AMENDING SECTION 2.08.050 OF THE BOROUGH CODE OF ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE A UNANIMOUS VOTE OF THE ASSEMBLY WITHOUT A ROLL CALL.

WHEREAS, the Assembly has ordained that all legislative actions must be taken before midnight at Assembly meetings; and

WHEREAS, it is the Assembly's intention to foster rules and regulations and practices and procedures which will expedite the business of the Assembly; and

WHEREAS, on those occasions where the Assembly is unanimous in its position on a proposal or motion the taking of a roll call is a waste of time; and

WHEREAS, the state law does not require the recording of "yes" or "no" votes when the vote is unanimous;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That KPB 2.08.050 is amended to read:

2.08.050 Voting--Recording of decisions and actions. A. The final vote on each ordinance, [OR] resolution, or substantive motion [SHALL BE BY ROLL CALL AND THE] is a recorded "yes" or [AND] "no", [VOTES SHALL BE RECORDED] except that if the vote is unanimous it is only necessary to state in the journal of A[A]ssembly proceedings that the vote is unanimous. An Assembly member may call for a roll call vote at any time as prescribed by Mason's Rules.

Section 2. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
