


ORDINANCE CERTIFICATION

ORDINANCE 81-131

AUTHORIZING RECEIPT OF COASTAL ZONE MANAGEMENT FUNDS FOR REVISION OF THE DRAFT BOROUGH COASTAL ZONE MANAGEMENT PLAN TO REFLECT LOCAL CONCERNS AND DEVELOPMENTAL REQUIREMENTS.

WHEREAS, the Borough has participated in the development of a coastal development program since 1979; and

WHEREAS, public meetings were held in ten locations throughout the Borough in order to allow local residents the opportunity to review and discuss aspects of the preliminary plan and it was the consensus of the participants that the preliminary plan was too restrictive of developmental needs and was difficult to understand; and

WHEREAS, completion of the Borough Coastal Zone Development Program will require a final revision of the draft plan to incorporate local concerns raised by citizens at public hearings throughout the Borough and to hold an additional series of public hearings upon the final draft of the plan prior to submission to the Planning Commission and the Assembly; and

WHEREAS, adoption of the Borough Coastal Zone Development Program will stimulate the local economy, reduce conflicts between coastal land development uses and minimize the existing burdensome regulatory process; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska provides 90 percent of the funding for the preparation of the Borough's Coastal Zone Development Program and the Borough is required to provide a local matching share of ten percent; and

WHEREAS, an appropriation of \$40,000 has been made for the coastal development plan in the 1981-1982 budget and approximately \$10,000 of this amount will be required to match state funds for the preparation of the final development program and the funds are available from federal shared revenue;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Mayor is authorized to accept the sum of \$90,000 from the State of Alaska as a coastal management grant and that revenues in Coastal Zone Management Account No. 12.34180 are increased by that amount.


Section 2. That the sum of \$10,000 is transferred from Federal Revenue Sharing Funds Account No. 06-41810-3465 to Coastal Zone Management Account No. 12.38060 to be used as the Borough's ten percent matching funds.

Section 3. That the sum of \$100,000 is appropriated to the Borough's Coastal Zone Management Contractual Services Account No. 12-41635-3400.

Section 4. That the Mayor is authorized to negotiate and let a contract for the preparation and revision of the Borough's final draft Coastal Zone Development Program for an amount not to exceed \$100,000.

Section 5. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
