KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 81-132

PROVIDING TWO APPRAISER POSITIONS TO THE ASSESSING DEPARTMENT AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the Borough is charged by law with the responsibility to assess all real and personal property within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Assessor is required by law to assess real property on a cycle of the shortest period of time practicable; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly finds that the Borough Assessor strives to make assessments in the Borough on a biennial cycle; and

WHEREAS, delay in reassessment of property tends to result in abrupt increases in taxation because of increased tax valuations in an inflationary economy; and

WHEREAS, more frequent periodic assessments level off the impact of increased taxes from valuation increases;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That two appraiser positions deleted in the 1981-1982 Borough Budget are reestablished in the Borough Assessing Department.

Section 2. That the sum of \$32,155 is appropriated from the unappropriated surplus account to the Assessor-Appraisal Personal Services Account No. 01-41520.

Section 3. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
