KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 81-137

APPROPRIATING \$50,000 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED FUND BALANCE FOR THE CENTRAL PENINSULA INCINERATION FEASIBILITY STUDY AND AUTHORIZING SELECTION OF A CONSULTANT.

WHEREAS, the Borough exercises Borough wide solid waste powers; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly recognizes the need to conserve and efficiently utilize the lands used and available for landfills; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly also recognizes the desirability of energy recovery from solid wastes; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly finds that it is in the short and long run interests of the Borough to determine the feasibility of incineration in the solid waste disposal program;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Mayor is authorized to procure the services of a qualified professional consultant to prepare a Central Peninsula Incineration Facility Study as a part of the Borough's planning in the conduct of the solid waste program.

Section 2. That the unappropriated portion of the general fund for Fiscal Year 1981-1982, Unappropriated Surplus Account No. 01-66900-0000, is reduced in the amount of \$50,000; and the appropriation in Solid Waste Capital Projects Account No. 63-28081-9007 (Central Peninsula Incineration Facility) is increased by \$50,000.

Section 3. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
