ORDINANCE 81-73

ESTABLISHING THE POSITIONS OF ENGINEERING TECHNICIAN III IN THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, SENIOR CLERK TYPIST IN THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, LAND MANAGEMENT AGENT IN THE RESOURCE PLANNING DEPARTMENT, AND GENERAL SERVICES TECHNICIAN IN THE FINANCE DEPARTMENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF COMPLYING WITH HCS CSSB 168 (FINANCE) 1981 SESSION.

WHEREAS, the 1981 State Legislature has approved HCS CSSB 168 (Finance), which is an act relating to assistance for municipalities and unincorporated communities and providing for an effective date; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough will receive \$13,704,000 from this appropriation for capital projects; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to develop, design, and administer these capital projects; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough does not have sufficient staff to properly administer these projects; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department is in need of an Engineering Technician III and a Senior Clerk Typist to review and develop plans and specifications for bidding and administration of projects; and

WHEREAS, the Resource Planning Department will require a Land Management Agent to assist in planning and acquiring right-of-way for these projects; and

WHEREAS, the Finance Department will need a General Services Technician to assist all departments within the Borough in the reproduction of large quantities of plans, specifications, bid documents, and other printing requirements and supply requirements to properly administer these capital projects; and

WHEREAS, support equipment will be needed by Public Works and Resource Planning personnel; and

WHEREAS, interest earnings on funds advanced by the State may be used to cover these costs; and

WHEREAS, the positions are to be paid from State derived revenues; and

WHEREAS, these positions will no longer be needed upon completion of the State funded projects;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. The following positions are established in the departments shown for the balance of fiscal year 1981-82:

Section 2. Interest earnings derived from funds received in the capital project account in accordance with HCS CSSB 168 (Finance) 1981 Session will remain in the General Fund and \$153,933 is hereby appropriated to be utilized as indicated in Sections 3, 4, and 5.

Section 3. The sum of \$60,300 is appropriated to the Public Works Department salary account 01.41710. The sum of \$34,500 is appropriated to the Resource Planning Department, Land Management Division, salary account 15.41615. The sum of \$24,133 is appropriated to the Finance Department, Administration Division, salary account 01.41410.

Section 4. The sum of \$30,000 is appropriated to the Public Works Department for office machines and vehicles, Account Nos. 01.41710.8200 and 01.41710.8400.

Section 5. The sum of \$5,000 is appropriated to the Resource Planning Department, Land Management office furniture account 15.41615.8100.

Section 6. Positions authorized by this ordinance will lapse upon completion of the State funded projects.

Section 7. This ordinance takes effect on September 1, 1981.
