ORDINANCE 81-85

AUTHORIZING THE RECEIPT OF \$8,396,640 STATE ASSISTANCE FOR MUNICIPALITIES PROVIDED BY HCS CSSB 168 (Finance) 1981 AND FOR SECONDARY ROAD DESIGN.

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska has notified the Kenai Peninsula Borough that the sum of \$7,331,640 has been allocated to the Borough from the State of Alaska Municipal Assistance Fund for the development of capital projects; and

WHEREAS, the sum of \$1,065,000 has been appropriated by the Legislature to the Kenai Peninsula Borough to be used for secondary road engineering and design; and

WHEREAS, HCS CSSB 168 (Finance) 1981 Session requires that the legislative body adopt an ordinance authorizing the municipality to receive and spend the money provided by the entitlement; and

WHEREAS, the Borough, by separate resolution, is providing a list of all capital projects to be completed on receipt of the entitlement;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Mayor is authorized to accept \$7,331,640 as provided under HCS CSSB 168 (Finance) 1981 Session and the sum of \$1,065,000 provided for secondary road engineering and design.

Section 2. Estimated Revenue entitled State Assistance and secondary road engineering and design is increased by the sum of \$8,396,640, and the appropriation in the General Fund for transfer to Capital Projects is increased by \$8,396,640 (Account Number 01.41990.7605).

Section 3. As funds are received from the State, they will be transferred from the General Fund to the Capital Projects Fund. No expenditures will be made or authorized prior to the actual receipt of these monies.

Section 4. This ordinance is effective immediately upon enactment.
