KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 81-94

APPROPRIATING \$120,000 FROM THE BOROUGH'S UNAPPROPRIATED SURPLUS TO PROVIDE FOR THREE MOBILE HOUSING UNITS FOR TEACHERS AT THE TYONEK SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, the School Board has ascertained that there is a serious shortage of housing for teachers assigned to the Tyonek School; and

WHEREAS, this shortage of housing for teachers at Tyonek School is acute; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has traditionally provided housing at remote school locations for teachers assigned to those remote schools; and

WHEREAS, the present lack of teacher housing at Tyonek will fall most heavily upon those teachers who intend to bring their families with them to live at Tyonek and the difficulties associated with this shortage will cause serious disruption to the school program at Tyonek;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the amount of \$120,000 is appropriated from the Borough's unappropriated surplus to the General Fund Account - transfer to Capital Projects Account No. 01-41990-7605, and is transferred to the Tyonek Teacherage Contingency Account No. 61-18782-9007, to be utilized to purchase, transport and install three mobile housing units for rental to teachers assigned to the Tyonek School.

Section 2. That the Mayor is authorized to effectuate this ordinance, which takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
