KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 82-8

ENACTING SECTION 1.25.01 ESTABLISHING PREFERENCE FOR DISABLED AMERICAN VETERANS RESIDING IN THE BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, the country owes a debt to those individuals who served in the armed forces of the United States; and

WHEREAS, those servicemen who are crippled and disabled as a result of their service to their country are at an economic disadvantage; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly finds that disabled American veterans who reside in the Borough should be accorded reasonable concessions and preferences; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly finds that land available for disposition to the public should allow for a disabled American veteran preference;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That a new Chapter 1.25 is enacted to provide:


Section 1.25.01. Disabled American veterans-- Preference--Land sales. In any disposition of Borough lands by public sale a disabled American veteran who is a one year minimum resident of the Borough and maintains a permanent place of abode in the Borough shall be entitled to the maximum resident's credit of 50% of the purchase price of the land if the veteran qualifies as a participant in the land sale and is a successful purchaser at that sale; provided, however, that the land sale ordinance provides for residence credits to purchasers at the land sale.

Section 1.25.02. Disabled American veteran-- Definition. For purposes of this chapter, a disabled American veteran is a resident of the Borough maintaining a permanent place of abode in the Borough

who has a 50% permanent disability as determined by the United States Veterans Disability Pension Program, or is a veteran who is totally disabled within the meaning of the United States Social Security Act. A disabled American veteran is a person who served in any of the United States armed services including the Merchant Marine, in WWI, WWII, the Korean or Vietnam War, or any service in these armed forces during or after these wars.

Section 2. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
