KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 82-54

ADJUSTING THE BOUNDARIES OF THE EAST KENAI PENINSULA ROAD MAINTENANCE SERVICE AREA TO COMPLY WITH ALASKA'S REVISED ELECTION PRECINCTS.

WHEREAS, the Assembly enacted Ordinance 82-28 which established the East Kenai Peninsula Road Maintenance Service Area; and

WHEREAS, the boundaries of the East Kenai Peninsula Road Maintenance Service Area were written to coincide with precinct boundaries on October 13, 1981; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska has revised election precinct boundaries within the Kenai Peninsula Borough; and

WHEREAS, the boundaries of the Road Maintenance Service Areas should coincide with the Assembly Election Districts to facilitate the election process;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That Section 16.52.010 of the Borough Code of ordinances is repealed.

Section 2. That Section 16.52.010 of the Borough Code of ordinances is re-enacted to read:

16.52.010 Established--boundaries. A service area is established within the Borough designated as the "East Kenai Peninsula Road Maintenance Service Area" including that portion of the Borough described as follows:

Being all land within the boundaries of the State Voting precincts of Bear Creek, Cooper Landing east of the westerly boundary of the Kenai National Moose Range within T6N R4W and T5N R4W, Hope and Moose Pass, excepting the City of Seward.

Section 3. That this ordinance takes effect on the date of its enactment.
